

Creating Formative Assessments in Galileo Using Quiz Builder

**Quizzes created in Quiz Builder may only be taken online. Directions for taking the quizzes online are located at the end of this document.*

Once you located the **Risk Assessment Report** (see **Using Galileo** handout) click on one of the risk levels.

When the next screen appears, you will see a list of PO's below each risk level. You will then see a button called **Quiz Builder**. Clicking on this button will allow you to create formative assessments aligned to the listed POs.

1. Determine the objectives for which you'd like to generate quizzes
2. Uncheck the objectives for which you don't want to generate quizzes.
3. Select the library that will house the quizzes. (Select the library that corresponds to the teacher's grade level.)
4. Select the dates and times for which you would like to have students take the quiz or quizzes by clicking on the calendar icons.
5. Click on the **Generate Quizzes** button.


Taking Quizzes Online

2. Click on **K-12 Student/Parent Center**



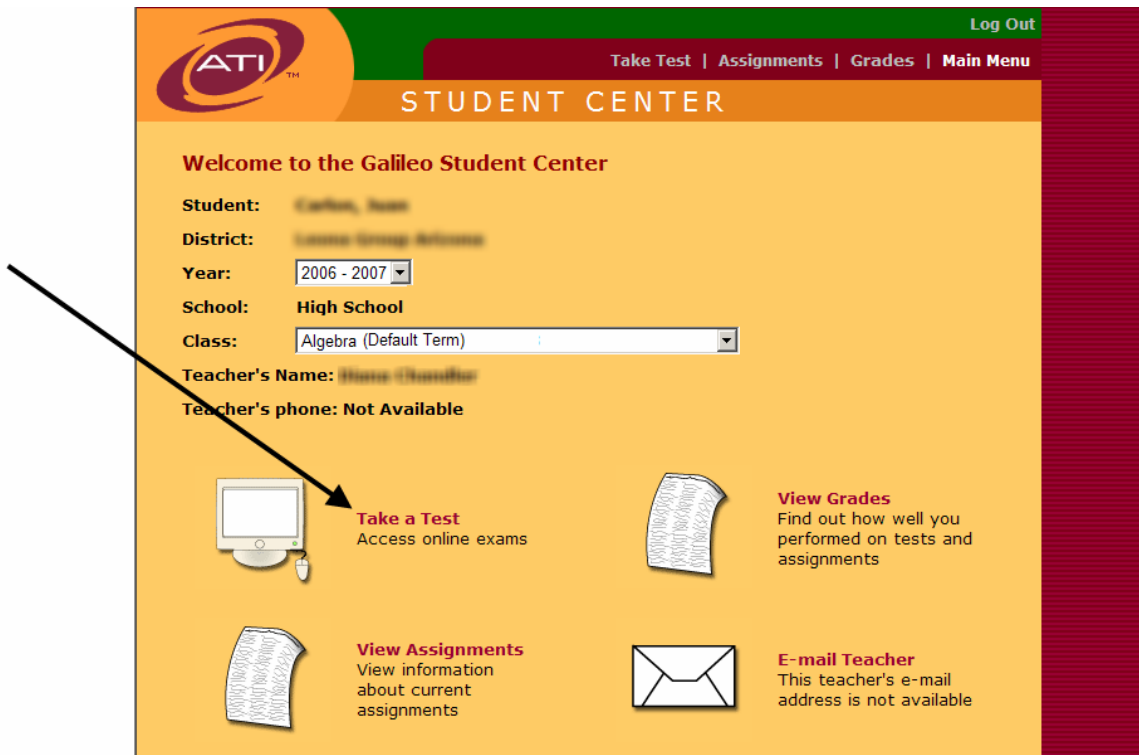

3. Students login to Galileo with the **User/Login Name** and **Password** that has been provided for them.

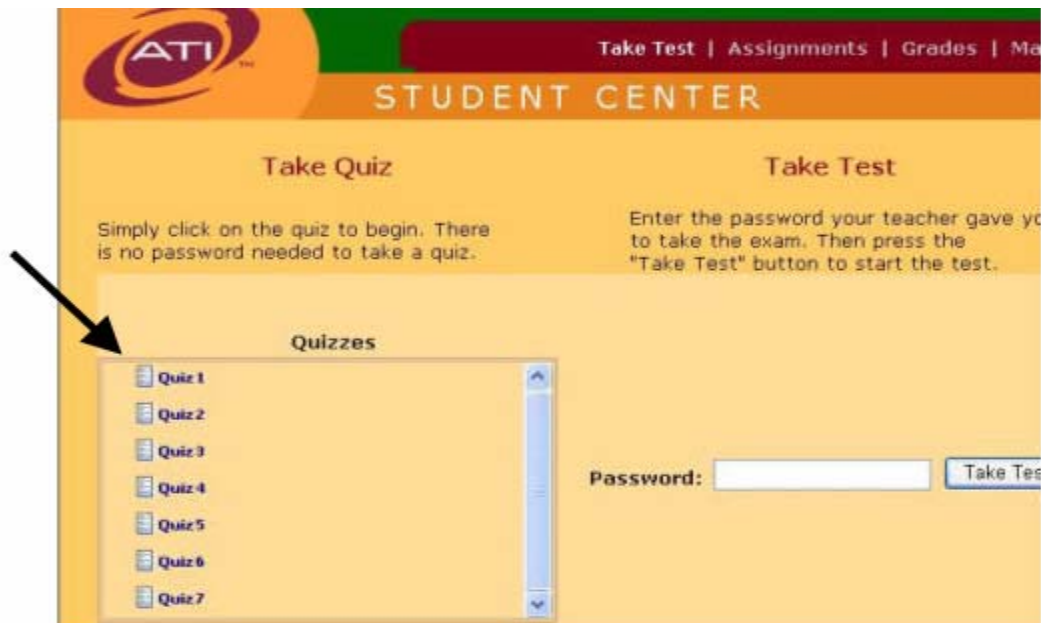
